


THE PROJECT

The Triple Short Film project is an innovative debut project by self-taught Independent Filmmaker/Producer Nathan A. Quattrini. He has created 3 short films of varied genres, but with a central connecting theme of Action. It allows him to showcase his ability to create different moods and styles of film. It also allows the starring actor, David Lavalley Jr. (who is also debuting), to showcase his variety of acting skills. The entire project has been accomplished on a barter and volunteer basis, which is almost unheard of for the level of quality produced. The 3 short films of the project are:

Sons of Lemuria

Genre : Drama/Action

Runtime : 19 min.

Starring : Brandon Luis Aponte, David Lavalley Jr., Sarah Nicklin, Colin Carlton

In the once beautiful Land of Lemuria, the Age of the ruling Warlock is coming to an end. Their corruption and mistreatment of the people and the Land had lead to their demise, leaving only 2 alive to carry on the bloodline. The story follows Zarrius, a local hero to the town of Isis, as he makes the most difficult choice of all. He leaves his family and everything he knows behind in order to put a stop to his brother's tyranny. Decius is following the path of corruption, and Zarrius is his only equal in strength and skill amongst men. Will the fate of Lemuria follow the path of purity? Or corruption?

Five Minutes Flat

Genre : Martial Arts Action

Runtime : 7 min.

This adrenaline filled short follows a prisoner trying to escape his captivity. In the training camp the captives are trained to excel in speed, agility, and power. They are not sure what they are being trained for, but know that if they fail any of the tests, they will die. There is only one chance for survival, and that is to challenge the one in charge. David must use all of his training to earn the ultimate prize, his freedom.

American Chop Suey

Genre : Comedy

THE EVENT
